Shall the Suffield Charter section 302 be amended to provide that the WPCA annual budget must be submitted to the Board of Finance for review, comment and advice?		3. Shall the Suffield Charter be amended to provide an addition to Charter section 502 "Powers and Duties" (The First Selectman), subsection F which will give the First Selectman executive authority in consultation with any board or commission over town employees on matters requiring consistency and coordination across Town Departments and their employees?		4. Shall section 611 "Director of Finance", subsection A of the Suffield Charter be amended to add a requirement that the Board of Finance and Board of Selectmen must meet 90 days prior to the expiration of the Director of Finance's appointment to discuss the reappointment of the Director of Finance to a new term?		5. Shall the Suffield Charter be amended by deleting Charter section 706 "Appointed Boards and Commissions", subsection P thereby deleting the reference to the Public Works Commission?		6. Shall the Suffield Charter be amended to change the rules in Section 802 "General Powers and Duties of the Board of Finance" limiting the number of members seated at a meeting to 6 members and to eliminate the different treatment accorded regular member and alternate members of the Board of Finance from Charter section 804 "Other Financial Matters", subsection D?		7. Shall the Suffield Charter Section 1006 "Actions Requiring a Town Meeting", subsection G be amended to provide that real estate leases that are in excess of an aggregate of 5 years would require Town Meeting approval and that leases of exactly 5 years or less do not require Town Meeting approval?		8. Shall the Suffield Charter be amended to change Charter section 1006 "Actions Requiring a Town Meeting", subsection H to remove the Town's acceptance of roads in new developments from the Town Meeting requirement if they are constructed in accord with plans approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission?		9. Shall the Suffield Charter sections 1008 "Limitations Regarding Appropriations" and 1009 "Referendum by Petition" subsection C be amended to lower the limits for a petition for a (non-budget) referendum from 10% of registered voters to 6% and to a) add a time limit for the gathering of signatures of 21 days from the date of the action for which the referendum is sought and b) to expressly limit signatures to those obtained after the action for which the referendum is sought?
