

PARKS SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Parks Superintendent Tom Drakeley presented his report to the Commission. The truck is fixed however the four wheel drive is not working. After a brief discussion Commissioner Reilly made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Noble, to allocate up to \$ 750.00 to get the four wheel drive and the license plate light repaired. The motion was made and carried unanimously. Mr. Drakeley would also like several loads of sand for the beach area. He will clear out the weeds and spread the sand himself. The hand wash machines will be removed for winter at the end of October. He has also weed wacked Stony Brooke Park.

Mr. Drakeley then handed out several pictures and discussed potential future projects at these areas. The bridge to the lower field needs new decking and the walkway to the bathroom next to the pavilion needs replacing. There is also a cable from the electrical pole along the walkway that is a hazard. After discussion, it was decided that Commissioner Benito will call the electrical company to discuss relocating the cable.

CONSULTANT'S REPORT

Consultant Morris asked for clarification of an informal discussion held at a previous meeting regarding proposed work at Deep Brook Harbor. The work involves connecting the two existing detention ponds with an open channel. The Commission asked for a plan showing the proposed grading that could be reviewed by Consultant Morris and the Town Engineer.

Consultant Morris then informed the Commission that the October 11th meeting of the Commission will be held in the upstairs conference room at town hall due to a scheduling conflict.
