



After discussion, Commissioner Neilson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Noble, to conceptually approve the revised plans with the following conditions:

1. All conditions of the original permit issued on November 15, 2010 remain in affect.
2. As per the Town Engineer's request, as outlined in his memo to the Commission dated March 8, 2011, the applicant shall submit details on the bridge end wall design and construction.

The motion was made and carried unanimously.

This property is located on the north side of Sheldon Street, nearest intersection being Rosewood Drive. Assessor's Map 23, Block 24, Lot b15A. This permit is granted as a Summary Ruling as the project does include wetland impacts. This permit will expire on March 9, 2014. The filing fee has been waived.
