350th Anniversary Celebration

The 350th anniversary of the settlement of Suffield is October 12th, 2020. The Board of Selectmen created a committee to organize the commemoration:

- The 350th Anniversary Committee's mission shall be to regularly meet to plan and coordinate a series of events, learning activities and social and cultural opportunities which will lead to an awareness and appreciation by all about the rich, 350 year history, life experience and growth of the Town of Suffield.
- The committee's goal encompasses developing strategies and planning events that allow opportunities for the greatest amount of town wide participation. It will further seek public and private contributions in its effort to highlight Suffield's rich political, social, cultural, economic, educational, agricultural and religious history.
- The 350th anniversary observance shall create a stronger sense of community, enhance tourism and promote continued economic growth and prosperity in the Town of Suffield (approved by the Board of Selectmen 6/7/17).
- → The First Selectman, serving as ex officio, and nine (9) members will comprise the 350th Anniversary Committee from its inception in June, 2017 through the events completion in 2020 (approved by the Board of Selectmen 6/7/17).

The First Meeting

The committee's recommendation is that the 350th anniversary be a year-long celebration!

- ♦ The 350th "big weekend" is Friday, October 9th through Monday, October 12th, 2020
- ♦ Other 350th anniversary celebration events will start on December 31st, 2019 and run throughout 2020
- Every resident, club, student, school group, non-profit organization and business should have an opportunity to participate if they wish to

Initially, the committee will be organized into 5 focus areas:

Events (including projects and programs) that celebrate Suffield's wonderful open spaces, it's rich history, and it's exciting future

Communications – to give everyone in town a way to share their ideas, and to keep up-to-date on what is being planned

Outreach – to get people and organizations interested in participating – engage schools, churches, businesses, clubs, associations, and nonprofits

Fundraising – to encourage private donations and apply for grants to help fund projects, programs, and events

Finance – to insure that event costs and benefits are understood, and insure that funds raised are spent wisely




