Minutes of March 22, 2023:

MOTION: It was MOVED by Sam Coatti, SECONDED BY Corbin Adzigirey, to approve the March 22, 2023 minutes with the following corrections:

- 2. The following had been left out of a statement by Jerry Mahoney: he summarized the book removed from display, noted that parents were absent in the book, and voiced his opinion that, legally, the library collection must be neutral and unbiased.

<u>Suffield Library Foundation</u> presentation by Mel Chafetz, chair of the Suffield Library Foundation,

Mel explained that the foundation was formed as a direct result of the 2006 or 2007 discussion of a new library building. Donors were concerned that money given to the commission or town would be used for other means, so a 501c3 was formed to allow donors to give to specific library projects.

The Foundation has funded many projects at the library (through donors), such as 1.1 million to offset town expenses on library renovations. It has hosted programs like speakers like Steve Kats and Greg Buttler. And is presently considering raising funds to upgrade the atrium and the historical room.

Cynthia Sinopoli asked how people became members of the Foundation. Mel spoke about seeking people in finance and fundraising.

Jerry Mahoney inquired how the goals and accomplishments are memorialized and how the public knows for what the money is being used. Mel said that previous projects are mentioned in fundraising letters.

The Foundation also receives requests from the Library Director about projects the town approves but won't finance.

Austin Roberts thanked Mel for all the work he and the foundation do and their incredible support of the library and its patrons.
